



MINUTES

I. WELCOME

President – Craig Walter opened the meeting at 7:02 p.m.

II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES – Kim Walts

The minutes of the February 16th meeting were accepted as submitted via email.

III. PRESIDENT’S REPORT – J. Craig Walter

- Middle School Track Meets – First meet is scheduled for March 25th.
- Calls will be made to Track Membership in an effort to increase Booster Club membership and volunteer participation.
- Track Equipment – Equipment is currently being stored under the football bleachers, in various coaches’ offices, etc. Coach Cook, Craig Walter and Coach Vandeford are all working on ideas for a more permanent storage facility. Reminder that the Trailer/Storage is on hold until more information is available on the new facilities.

IV. TREASURER’S REPORT – Sharon Fritts(Zeller)

- Current bank account balance is \$11,172.52 in the Wachovia Account.
- Minor activity this month (member dues, spirit wear).

V. COMMITTEE REPORTS

- **Membership** – There are two (2) new members to the Booster Club. We will continue to push for more members from track parent group.
- **Spirit Wear** – Alicia Waterman asked for feedback on the NIKE track-wear. Coach Cook was not happy with the amount of time it took to get the items ordered. Parents/Members also expressed displeasure with the pricing, although everyone agreed the quality was nice. Another issue mentioned was the the sizing – all items are very large.
- **Sponsorship** – Neither Scott Sanderson or Vickie Gulley were present to report. Sponsorship will be updated at next meeting.
- **Banquet** – Karen Hazboun reported the Track Banquet will be held on May 22nd at Tour18 Golf Club. The dinner will be BBQ with all the trimmings. There will be a silent auction held during the banquet. Discussion was held on whether or not to charge a higher price to non-booster club members for banquet tickets. No motion was made & the discussion was tabled.
- **MS Track Concessions – Marleen Milles** Marleen reported that everything is on schedule for the concession stand. There will be a cleanup day soon. Volunteers will be needed to work the middle school meets as well as the Jaguar Invitational Meet.

VI. Coaches Report: Coach Andrew Cook

- Goldsmith Relays at Lewisville were rescheduled to Thursday, March 11 due to conflict with soccer. Current schedule is on FMTrack.Org.
- Coach announced that the team is winning many 2nd & 3rd place medals. He is looking for more from the relay teams. The girls team is showing strong potential in the 4x100 and the 4x200. The boys 4x400 should be very strong. He also note that the team is a little “banged up” right now, so Spring Break will be a nice opportunity for recovery.
- Coach reminded that he needs signed permission slips for all athletes that will be missing school for meets.

VII. Old Business

- **Jaguar Invitational** - Craig announced that some Sub-Chair positions still need to be filled. Some general discussion of positions still open. Volunteers to sign up after meeting. Email blast will go out to solicit volunteers to fill any remaining spots.
- **End of Year Run** – Discussion was held regarding whether or not to hold the End-Of-Year Run. Points made against were that it is difficult to get into the Elementary Schools for recruiting runners; no one has volunteered to coordinate; 100+ kids needed to be financially beneficial; so many other events are held on that same weekend. The only point in favor of having the run was that the kids that do participate always look forward to the event. Alicia Waterman moved to table the Run for one year and then revisit the possibility of hosting. Barbara Walther seconded. The motion carried.

VIII. New Business

- **Auditors** – End of year auditors for books are needed. Alicia Waterman, Barbara Walther, Tracy Walter and Donna Moore volunteered.
- **Flower Mound (CC) Invitational T-Shirt Sales** – Vendor on site will customize shirts & screen on site. There will be a large price range. Vendor's artists will create a design for the meet. Base price for all t-shirts will include a design on the front & any sponsors on the bank. Commission will be paid to the Booster Club on whatever they sell, in cash, that day. Bonus is available for multiple meets in one year. Note that FMHS will host the District Track Meet in 2011. Any sponsors would pay a fee to have their names on back of the shirt(s) which would be FULL PROFIT. More discussion on these details to come at next meeting.
- **Door Prize** – AMC \$10 Movie card was awarded to Donna Moore.

The next meeting will be held April 6th in the Field House at 7:00 p.m. A motion was made to adjourn by Alicia Waterman; seconded by Karen Hazboun. The meeting was adjourned at 7:54 p.m.
